## ➤ Making Housing Affordable

Rick Jennings helped make Sacramento the first Pro-Housing city in California and led Streamline Sacramento **to cut red tape and speed up housing approvals.** He will keep pushing for more **homes that working families and seniors can afford** because Sacramento should be a place where people can put down roots and build a future.

## ➤ Addressing Homelessness

Rick has **expanded shelter and supportive housing** while pushing for the behavioral health and addiction services people need to get back on their feet. He believes Sacramento must keep investing in solutions that work — and that as shelter and housing options grow, **neighborhoods deserve to see real relief on the ground. Rick will keep fighting for both.**

## ➤ Keeping Our Neighborhoods Safe

**Rick Jennings helped drive a 19% drop in crime through investments in public safety and prevention programs.** He completed pedestrian safety improvements at schools and high-priority intersections, and he will keep working to **improve bike trails and make streets safer** for everyone who walks, rides, or lives along them.

## ➤ Investing in Our Youth

Rick Jennings built a nonprofit serving over 1,000 at-risk youth each day and championed a local measure to secure dedicated funding for youth programs. **He'll keep protecting that funding and expanding programs that support kids and families.**
